TOLEDO METRO GOLF ASSOCIATION RULES



- All mailed entries/fees must be received no later than the Tuesday prior to any scheduled event. The same deadline applies for refunds/cancellations. (See TMGA schedule for "Last Payment Date".) Mail entries/fees to TMGA; P.O. Box 140126; Toledo, OH; 43614-0308. Entries/fees will also be accepted after the completion of any round at all prior TMGA events. Mail entries early because they go through Detroit first and take longer-e-mail if mailed late so we know it's coming!!!
- Tee times and pairings are made on Tuesday evenings. Preferred pairings and tee times are honored as much as possible. Late entries are used only to complete foursomes. Starting the Thursday prior to all scheduled events, visit www.toledometroglf.com for tee times and pairings.
- The TMGA plays by USGA rules including playing the ball as it lies (i.e., "Summer Rules"). Any exceptions or other local rules are posted at all tournament sites on the rule board. Generally, back or next to back tee boxes are used for most events, but shorter tee placements are used at lengthier venues.
- Slow play will not be tolerated! Slow play policies are posted and enforced at all events. "Ready Play" is required at all TMGA events. Please note 20 minute rule!!
- Sandbagging will not be tolerated! The Toledo Metro has adopted a USGA provision regarding tournament handicaps. Those players who are not using the TMGA handicapping system must present their updated handicap index at tournament sites after completing each round. In addition, players lacking the minimum number of recorded scores required below each TMGA event will have their handicaps adjusted downward. (See TMGA letter for details.) Learn 2017 handicap rules!
- TMGA members should observe and promote proper golf etiquette at all times. Proper attire and spikeless shoes are required. Caddies and rangefinders (without slope) are allowed.
- Ties in both handicap and scratch divisions for regular Metro events will equally share prize money and player of year points. For other championships a playoff as determined by the Metro will take place. Players not present will forfeit 1st place POY points, but prize dollars will be evenly divided.
- If you wish to withdraw from any TMGA event, text Jim O'Neal (419-350-2421) or e-mail oniegolf1@cs.com by 9 p.m. on the Tuesday preceding the event. You can then choose to receive a full refund of your entry fee or transfer your entry and fee toward a future event.
